We will learn a new blend everyday and follow the Read Write Inc. scheme to help us make lots of progress with our reading and writing.

We will be learning to: Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. We will be taking photographs and use them to create our own mini beast fact file.

In Art

We will be learning to: Choose, use and mix our own colours to create quality art work that shows progression in skills. The children will have the opportunity to create their own minibeasts using paint and looking at patterns and colour.
