## MAGNIFICENT MOUNTAINS

### English

This half-term we will be exploring poems, creating our very own mountain-inspired Calligrams. We will be investigating chronological text, writing our very own report based on the water cycle.

### Geography

In Geography we will be learning to describe key aspects of physical geography, including climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts, rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes, and the water cycle.

### Art/ DT

In art and DT we will be creating mountain models. We will then have the opportunity to present these to the class. We will also be investigating Adi tribes and creating our very own Adi-inspired weave.

### Maths

In maths, we will be learning about the place value of numbers up to one million! We will battle out on TT rockstars in a Lynher whole class tournament to recap our times tables.

### Music

In music, we will be learning the song 'Mamma Mia' whilst exploring instruments including; the glockenspiel. Lynher will be creating a class song that explains the water cycle and its importance.

### French

In French, we will be recapping basic greets, our numbers to 20 and the common colours.
