Communication and Language

The children will be doing settling in activities so they get to know their new school environment, They will be making new friends, The children will be talking about experiences that are familiar to them and about family routines and special occasions, They will show an interest in the lives of other people, follow instructions (settling in, putting my things away) and develop new vocabulary

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

For the first half term we will be doing lots of work on getting to know each other, learning class routines and rules.

The children will have opportunities to share their 'All about me' boxes over the first few weeks and talk about things that are important to them. They will also learn through our SCARF lessons 'What makes me special'

Physical Development

The children will explore a range of climbing, balancing and sliding apparatus, wheeled toys, bats and balls, hoops etc. in the outside area. The children will be learning about how to live a healthy lifestyle through exercising and looking at health foods to eat.

Every Friday will be 'Funky Finger Friday' where we focus on the children's fine motor skills, eg cuttings with scissors,

Literacy

We will be looking at books that are familiar to the children e.g. The Gruffalo, Elmer, Hairy McClary.

Phonics: We will start 'Read, Write Inc. phonics from week 3 (More information will follow about this)

Mathematics

In Maths the children will be learning about Matching and Sorting, Comparing different amounts and Making simple patterns.

We use Numberblocks to help us with how numbers are made and this half term we will be focussing on 1,2 and 3.

The children will also learn about 'subitising' which is the ability to see an amount without counting it.

Understanding the World

The children will be identifying who is in their family, and the differences from their friend's family. They will be learning about different occupations and ways of life.
