We hope you all continue to remain safe and well.

School Update

Two full weeks back at school and the children are still impressing us all with their flexibility and acceptance of our current structure and procedures. Well done to our reception children who continue to confidently bound into their classroom and are now attending for full days.

We aim to nurture a positive mindset in our children. This flows through the school from class to class and teacher to teacher. Despite the recent developments concerning Covid-19 our outlook will remain optimistic about remaining fully operational.

Should we find ourselves in a situation where we experience a localized case or small cluster outbreak at school which could result in certain/all classes being temporarily closed, we will endeavor to inform you as quickly as we can, and with as little disruption as possible, however, there are some things which remain out of our direct control.

As always on a return to school we have a few 'sickness bugs' this week. These can affect our children and staff. This happens every year. This may result in some children missing a short period of time form school. Just to remind you – The NHS reports that the three main symptoms of Corona Virus to be watchful for are:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus, get a test to check if they have coronavirus as soon as possible. Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get the test result – only leave your home to have a test. Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get the result.

Weekly Planning

To help further support our children and their education. From Monday all our teachers will be uploading the weekly lesson planning and a few resources to their class pages on our school website. This will enable all children to have access to the learning activities should they be absent from school – whether this is for a day or two with a bug or bad cold, or for a longer period of time, should they or their household need to isolate.

Car Park

Please be aware that currently we are operating a one-way system which involves pedestrian access through the carpark. Please escort your children safely when exiting the school.

Also, please park safely, especially if you use the spaces just outside the gates, as these can create blind spots and increase the risk of accidents occurring.

Finally, please **do not** allow your child(ren) to climb the grass bank in the car park. If you wish to leave by the gate near our entrance use the steps by our minibus only.
