#### Trauma Informed School (TIS) Approach

The recent two years of life with the Covid-19 situation has led to many people experiencing the challenges differently. This is particularly true with children who have faced the challenges of Covid-19 and the uncertainty it brings to life on the front line. We have heard from many parents how their children and their family's life has altered and become noticeably more stressful throughout this time.

In each individual case our school is proud of the patience, support and care given to the children and their families during these challenging times. It often requires our staff utilising their natural love for the child and their TIS skills to show the child that in an uncertain world they can be certain of the warm relationship and safe environment our school provides. Many schools have adopted this approach throughout Aspire, Cornwall and nationally.

Our staff are fully dedicated in providing this stable, safe and warm environment on a consistent basis. It can mean that children may require an intense amount of support at times during the day whilst they re-focus themselves to be in a place to learn effectively.

Remember that our staff are here to listen and support all parents with any issues concerning the welfare of all our children.

Due to the current road works drop-off and collection times currently present added risk. Please remain patient at these times and watchful for our children, especially when they are exiting a vehicle. Thank you.



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
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## **School Camps**
