Changes to Ordering System for School Lunches

After half term children will no longer order lunches from the classroom. This will now be the parents responsibility to order their child's lunch via Parent Pay and submit payment at the time of ordering. This can be ordered up until 8.30am on the day lunch is required. Children in Class 1&2 and those children in receipt of free meals will need to order via parent pay too. Your child will have brought home instructions on how to order with a menu. Outstanding balances will be added as a separate payment where parents can pay the amount owed. Thank you for your anticipated co-operation with this new system.
