<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Place value• Addition and subtraction• Multiplication - counting in 2s, 5s and 10s• Shape <p><u>Things to practice</u></p> <p>Counting forwards & backwards within 10 or 20. Number bonds to 10 and 20.</p> <p><u>Science on Fridays</u></p> <p>Animals including humans - All about me. We will be identifying senses, parts of the body and how to take care of ourselves.</p> <p>Animals including humans - All about animals. We will be identifying and classifying animals, learning about growth, habitats and diet.</p> <p><u>Topic/Geography</u></p> <p>*The children will be using maps, atlases, and globes to name and locate the world's hot and cold climates, five oceans and seven continents.</p> <p>*We will be discovering exciting facts about our oceans and planet while identifying key physical and human features on ariel photographs of the shoreline.</p> <p><u>Computing on Wednesdays</u></p> <p>We will be learning how to stay safe online, following e-safety rules. We will use Chromebooks to learn how to log into websites such as Sumdog, Numbots and MyON.</p>	<p><u>Art and DT</u></p> <p>The children will be comparing past/present artists such as Alfred Wallis and Peter Matthews. Taking inspiration, they will make their own ocean paintings. Later in the term, we will be designing and making woven fish and Batik coasters.</p> <p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>The children will be thinking about their relationships and valuing differences.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>We will be listening to underwater sounds such as whale song. We will follow the COVID safe Charangra scheme. The children will play and compose live music.</p> <p><u>RE</u></p> <p>We will be learning about Creation in Christianity and celebrating Harvest Festival. We will find out what belonging to a faith community means.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>On Thursdays, please make sure your child comes to school dressed in their PE kit on Thursdays and Fridays (school jumper, white T shirt, shorts/jogging bottoms, plimsols/trainers).</p> <p><u>Thursday afternoons</u> Go Active Sports Coach</p> <p><u>Friday afternoons</u> Fundamental skills/ Dance with Miss Adler.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>This term we will be focusing on the following objectives.</p> <p><u>Year 1</u></p> <p>I can name letters of the alphabet in order.</p> <p>I can form capital letters of the correct size and orientation.</p> <p>I am learning to write sentences using finger spaces, a capital letter and a full stop.</p> <p>I can re-read what I have written to check that it makes sense.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Year 1 will continue with the Read Write Inc. program, focusing on Set 2 & 3 sounds.</p> <p>Words to read and spell will be weekly homework. Please let Miss Adler know if you need any help with this.</p> <p>An extra phonics reading book will be sent home with your child. This was successfully trialled in the summer term. It will contain sounds your child is learning in class. The books have useful questions to secure understanding.</p>
<p><i>Planet Earth</i> is our whole school theme this term. Within that theme our exciting topic is...</p> <p><u>Oceans Around our World</u></p> <p>We will be reading: The Snail and the Whale, Tiddler and The Rainbow Fish. The children will be writing instructions, stories, and poems.</p>
